

# AREA FUN DAYS

In 1999, the Association Services committee developed a new format, “Area Fun Days,” for providing direct service from the State Association to all Local Associations. “Area Fun Days” were the answer to changing times and the need to provide more information and better communications to our Local Association officers and directors. To accomplish this, the goal was smaller workshops where everyone in attendance could participate.

The Association Services committee selects the sites and dates for the “Area Fun Days.” The Local Association is asked to help in planning the event. Associations surrounding the hosting city are invited to attend. The “Area Fun Day” is a one-day event, starting with registration, a mini- workshop, luncheon, and a fun tournament. The first “Area Fun Day” held on August 22, 1999, was hosted by the Seymour WBA – there were 44 in attendance. The second was held on October 31, 1999, hosted by the Marion WBA. 28 women attended the event.
