Tournament Rules

~ Please Read Carefully ~

1. This is a handicap tournament consisting of a four-member team event (2 men and 2 women), a doubles event (1 man and 1 woman), and an optional all events.
 2. The ENTRY FEE is \$22.00 per person per event for team and doubles. Optional 6-game all events fee is \$5.00. Entries must be submitted with total fees in the form of a money order or cashier's check. NO PERSONAL CHECKS PLEASE.
 3. OPTIONAL ACTUAL EVENTS: The cost of each actual event is \$5.00. Any team or doubles pair who have entered and paid the fees for the regular tournament may enter the optional actual score event. To enter team actual all four bowlers must pay the fee, and to enter doubles actual both partners must do so. A participant may enter all events actual provided the fee is paid prior to bowling any event.
 4. All entrants must be Indiana USBC members. Bowlers must have a current season membership card when checking in to bowl or must purchase an associate membership (IS USBC BA fee is \$20.00; IS USBC WBA fee is \$21.00).
 5. AVERAGES: Bowlers will use their highest 2010-11 USBC league average, based on 21 games or more. If no 2010-11 average, use 2011 USBC summer league average for 21 games or more. If no winter or summer league average, bowler will use highest current USBC league average at the time of bowling, minimum of 12 games. All bowlers without a verified average will bowl scratch. USBC rules 319a-2 (10 pin rule), 319d (prize winnings), and 319e (entering average adjustment) will not apply.
 6. HANDICAP: Team handicap will be 90% of 880 and doubles handicap will be 90% of 440.
 7. MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION: Bowlers may enter the tournament any number of times in both the team and doubles event. At least two people must change each time they participate in the team event. Doubles entrants must have a different partner each time they participate. If entering optional all events, the fee must be paid prior to bowling any event. The first event score will be used for all events. Walk-in entries will be accepted up to 15 minutes prior to squad time based on lane availability.
 8. Bowlers shall be listed on the entry form in the order in which they will bowl. No changes will be made in the order of bowling once the entry is submitted. A substitute shall take the place of the original entrant in the lineup. Substitutes must be based on gender (male for male and female for female) and meet all tournament eligibility requirements. Substitutions shall be made at least 45 minutes prior to the scheduled bowling time.
 9. Correction of a bowler's average must be made by the end of the first game. Falsification of an average will result in disqualification from the tournament if submitted average is lower than correct average. If submitted average is higher than correct average, prize winnings will be based on submitted average. Each bowler is responsible for the accuracy of his/her average.
 10. Scoring errors must be reported to the Tournament Manager immediately.
 11. No more than two individuals who at the time of entry are current members, or who have applied for membership, in any bowling organization that identifies itself as "professional" may compete on a four-member team. Likewise, only one individual so identified may compete on a doubles team.
 12. Prize fund will be returned 100% with a ratio of at least one place for every eight entries in the team and doubles events – handicap and actual. All events prize ratio will be at least one for every 10 entries – handicap and actual. There will be separate all events prize funds for men and women. Handicap and actual awards will be presented to winners in each event. In the event of a tie for first place in any event, co-champions will be declared.
 13. ENTRY CLOSING date will be 15 minutes prior to the last squad of the tournament. Reservations will be accepted for four (4) or more teams. Entry fees for reserved spots must be paid within seven (7) days of making reservation or the time(s) will be released.
 14. Bowlers will check in 45 minutes before squad is scheduled to bowl. If bowler has not checked in 45 minutes prior to squad time, the spot is subject to release. Announcements and practice session will start 15 minutes before squad time. A bowler arriving after tournament play has started will receive zero for any frames missed.
 15. No drinking or eating will be permitted in the bowlers' area. **SMOKING WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN OR OUTSIDE THE BOWLING CENTER DURING YOUR COMPETITION.**
 16. The use of talcum powder, resin, etc., on shoes, or any other foreign substance that in any manner alters the normal conditions of the approach, is strictly prohibited.
 17. DRESS CODE: Appropriate attire is expected. Apparel such as halter tops, tank tops, short shorts/skirts, spandex, and T-shirts with derogatory language will not be permitted. The decision of the Tournament Manager will be final.
 18. USBC rules will be observed. The Tournament Manager will decide any other questions. The Tournament Manager's decision shall be final unless an appeal is made in writing to the Bowl Indiana Council in accordance with USBC Chapter 6, rule #329.
 19. The entrants whose names appear hereon or their authorized replacements hereby agree that the Bowl Indiana Council, their officers and agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if and when those entrants shall be prevented from bowling an event in the tournament through unexpected yet necessary schedule change or premature termination of the tournament, which may be brought about by war, national emergency or emergencies or causes relating thereto or resulting from fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond the control of the Bowl Indiana Council.
